

CCDRC SELECTS ANNUAL PRIORITIES

At its September meeting, the Clyde Community Development Resource Committee (CCDRC) set its priorities for the coming year. The #1 priority is to address housing issues in Clyde. A second priority is to support business development opportunities.

CCDRC made plans in September to launch a Welcoming Newcomers program by inviting Karla Danielson to provide that service.

Board member and school superintendent Cheryl Keim mentioned that the high school is organizing a community-wide cleanup in the spring. The CCDRC board agreed to lend support to that project.

(September was set as the annual planning meeting for CCDRC at the retreat held by the board this past winter.)

At the October meeting, CCDRC reviewed Clyde's housing market and discussed the development of a rental pamphlet for landlords. The board also approved writing an application to the Clyde Area Foundation for the Welcoming Newcomers program.
