Ordinance No. 701

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO SIDEWALKS PRESCRIBING WIDTH, MATERIAL, MANNER OF CONSTRUCTING SIDEWALKS IN THE CITY OF CLYDE, KANSAS; AMENDING SECTION 3 OF ORDINANCE NO. 485 AND REPEALING SAID ORIGINAL SECTION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF CLYDE, KANSAS:


Section 1. Section 3 is hereby amended to read as follows: That all sidewalks shall be built at established grade and shall be constructed of cement laid at least four (4) inches deep, not less than forty-eight (48) inches wide, with a minimum joint space of 36", must contain a minimum of 3/8" rebar, and a minimum depth of two (2) inches of sand, made in good workmanlike manner under the direction of the said city personnel.

Section 2. The original Section 3 of Ordinance No. 485 is hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official city newspaper.


