ORDINANCE NO. 608

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE MOWING, RAKING, DEPOSITING AND/OR PLACING OF GRASS AND WEED CLIPPINGS AND OTHER YARD DEBRIS ON. IN OR UPON ANY HIGHWAY, ROAD, STREET OR ALLEY AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF CLYDE, KANSAS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to mow, rake, deposit and/or place grass and weed clippings and other yard debris on, in or upon any highway, road, street or alley within the City of Clyde, Kansas. It shall be the responsibility of the person to remove or clean all grass, weed and leaves clippings and other yard debris from the street qutters, road, highway and alley following completion of yard work.

Section 2. Any person violating this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined in an amount not to exceed One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00). Each day's violation shall constitute a separate offense.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication in the Clyde Republican.
